The Bereavement Committee at St. Michael will offer a new season of Seasons of Hope, a six-week bereavement process centered on Jesus Christ and grounded in the healing wisdom, tradition, and practices of the Catholic Church. It

is open to anyone who is grieving the death of a loved one. Sessions are held at St. Michael Catholic Church in Greenfield, in the PLC Rm. 2, on Sunday afternoons from 1:30-3:30 p.m. The new season will begin on February 16, 2025 and conclude on March 23, 2025. Each session focuses on a specific topic and includes prayer, reading and reflecting on a passage of scripture, an opportunity to share common experiences, and a spiritual exercise to be completed in the privacy of your home. Communal praying of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy for our departed loved ones concludes each session.
